Issues related to freshwater scarcity such as climate change, deforestation, freshwater supply limit, pollution, etc.

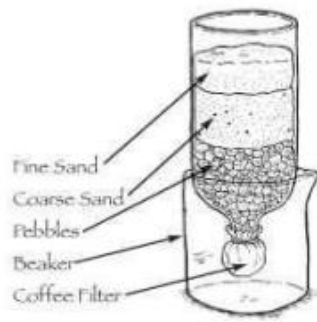
2) The National flag of India is our pride. Write a story on our national flag using pictures.

3) Make a model of *water filter*.

Things required: a clean plastic bottle, a glass, pebbles, gravel and sand.

Method:

- Cut off the bottom of clear plastic bottle and stuff the neck of the bottle with cotton wool.
- Turn the bottle upside down and place it on a clean glass.
- Over the cotton wool, spread the layer of small pebbles, then gravel and then sand.
- All pebbles, gravel and sand must be washed and dried before putting in the bottle.
- Pour dirty water over these layers of filter.
