NO HOMEWORK POLICY

To reduce the stress of students as well as parents, the school is following the 'NO HOMEWORK POLICY' as per the guidelines given by DOE.

Primary Classes

- ❖ The school management and administration has implemented 'NO HOMEWORK POLICY' for Classes Pre-Primary – II. This also implements 'School Bag Weight Reduction Policy'. All the notebooks and books remain at school. Students learn academically in the school. Only oral activities are given for homework. All the work pertaining to exercises given at the end of each unit or lesson in the textbooks are done during the school hours under the supervision of teachers. Students are encouraged to speak about the activities they had done at home.

Classes III – V

- ❖ As per the guidelines, only two hours of written homework on weekly basis is given to the students to reduce the stress. The homework is creatively framed in such a manner so as to make the child think 'out of the box'. The homework given is linked with the concepts taught in class given in different subject areas. Students interest is kept in mind while framing the assignments.

Classes VI-VIII

- ❖ As per the guidelines, only one hour of written homework on daily basis is given to the students to improve their concentration. Students focusses on environmental and contemporary issues that enriches their knowledge.

The school also ensures that the discussion and assessment of the homework is done on weekly basis. Also, the feedback is given on the same to make the child aware of their work done.
