Topic - 3 D Solar System

The Solar system is a group of celestial bodies bounded to each other by gravitational pull. This includes the eight planets and their moons, dwarf planets, and countless asteroids, comets, and other small, icy objects. The eight planets are Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune. It is around 4.6 billions years old. However, even with all these things, most of the solar system is empty space.


