The eight planets are Mercury, Venus, Earth, Mars, Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus and Neptune. It is around 4.6 billions years old. However, even with all these things, most of the solar system is empty space.

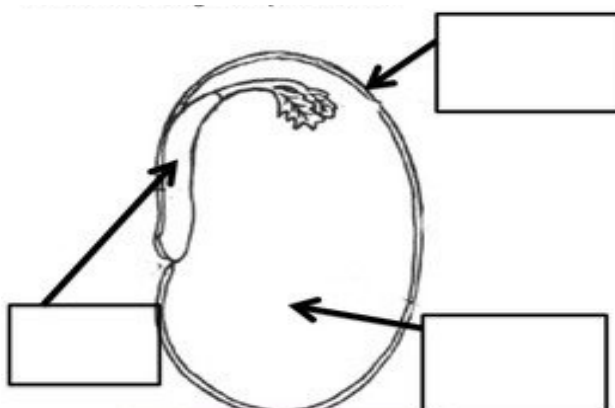
